

What has the MACBF team been asked do in Uganda on this trip?

- We have been asked to lead Vacation Bible School for the refugee children and neighborhood children. We might also be able to have a session with their parents.
- We will most likely be invited to visit with some refugees in their homes.
- We might be asked to do some repairs or acts of labor around the Centre of Hope.
- We will encourage, pray with, hug and experience the hope of Christ in our new friends.

How much will the trip cost?

Approximately \$3,000, (Airfare, Local travel, Lodging, Most meals, Visit to a Refugee or Internally Displaced People Camp, Short safari)

What is required?

- Letter of recommendation from your pastor
- Have a prayer partner throughout the process
- Background check
- Commitment of your home church to receive all funds for your trip
- Attendance at training sessions
- Read at least two books to assist you with better cultural understanding (list will be provided)
- Worship with an African church in the metro-DC area before going on the trip

- Connect with a refugee or immigrant in your home community and get to know him or her
- Pray for R&H, for the MACBF team, for your church's ministries
